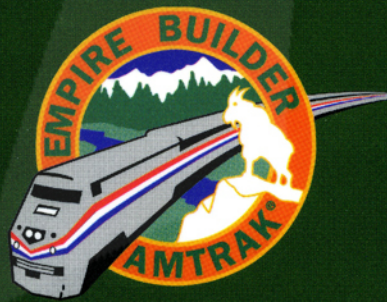

A New Spirit! Classic Service...Timeless Scenery



One of the great trains of America since 1929, the *Empire Builder* under Amtrak remains forever linked with Western history. It is a legacy beginning with conservation and the establishment of Glacier National Park, Montana (May 1910). Original park buildings, all railroad sponsored, include the station at East Glacier Park and magnificent Glacier Lodge (see cover painting).

East of Glacier, the *Empire Builder* bisects the great Blackfeet Reservation. The buffalo may be gone now, but hardly the pride and resiliency of the Blackfeet, who, like the *Empire Builder*, have adapted to changing times. History further recalls the contribution celebrated in the Blackfeet paintings of Winold Reiss (opposite). Not sentiment but rather the *Empire Builder* enlivened America's understanding of Blackfeet country, reason again, history concludes, to believe that railroads still forge togetherness.

So, too, the *Empire Builder* reveals the wonder of wilderness America as seen by Lewis and Clark (1804-1806). Portions of their route to the Pacific are either crossed or paralleled, and otherwise approximated both east and west. The Portland section retraces their footsteps down the Columbia River Gorge; in Montana, Meriwether Lewis and his party entered what is now the Blackfeet Reservation. Beginning in 2004, the Lewis and Clark Bicentennial should draw millions of eager visitors, and again, the *Empire Builder* promises to bring them west.

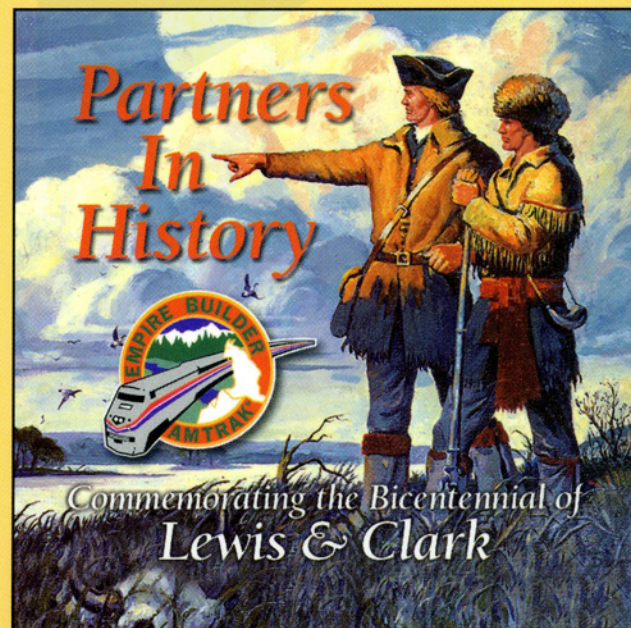
