For as little as \$115, and no more than \$200, your Amtrak Regional U.S.A. Rail Pass will give you 14 days of travel with unlimited stopovers on key routes in any one of America's major regions—Northeastern, Southern, Central and Western. If you travel together as a family, you'll be able to take advantage of very substantial price reductions for your spouse and children.

The great advantage of unlimited stopovers is that you can travel where you want and when you want within any region of your choice.

Travelling by Amtrak is the perfect way to enjoy the excitement and fun of touring in America. Amtrak gives you the freedom to really get to know the United States—close up and in comfort. And you'll have many opportunities to meet and make friends with Americans during your trips.

If you're travelling in the West or Midwest on Superliner routes, you'll be impressed with Amtrak's double-decker trains and be thrilled time and again with the panoramic views from these trains.

Amtrak, America's national rail passenger system, has introduced four special Regional U.S.A. Rail Passes for visitors coming to the United States.

Regional U.S.A. Rail Pass Conditions

1. The REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass is valid only when signed by the traveler and is not transferable. Travel must start within ninety (90) days of the date of sale shown on the front of the Pass.
2. The REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass is not valid for passage. Passengers must present the Pass at an Amtrak authorized ticket office for issuance of tickets. Tickets issued in conjunction with the Pass must be signed aboard the train in the presence of the Conductor. The REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass and identification for signature verification must be presented to the Conductor and Ticket Agent upon request.
3. Advance reservations for regular coach travel can only be made after purchase of the REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass. Advance reservations for club cars, sleeping cars, and Metroliners will be subject to further limitations prior to scheduled train departure. For further details, contact your appointed Amtrak Travel Agent.
4. Tickets issued in conjunction with the REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass are valid for regular coach travel (except Metroliners) on all Amtrak routes. A REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass holder may also travel in club cars, sleeping cars, and Metroliners upon payment of the appropriate additional charge, subject to the availability of such accommodations and to the limitation referenced in paragraph 3.
5. The REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass and all tickets issued in conjunction with it expire at midnight on the "END DATE" shown on the Pass. Passengers may not depart from any point, including an intermediate transfer point, after the expiration time of the Pass, unless a passenger's failure to depart from such point by the expiration time was caused by Amtrak, its agents, or its contractors.
6. Refund for an unused REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass may only be made prior to the "START DATE" shown on the Pass. Any refund is subject to applicable tariff regulations.
7. Amtrak is not liable for a REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass which is lost, stolen, or destroyed.
8. Any alteration of the REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass or tickets issued in conjunction with the Pass will invalidate them.
9. All tickets issued in conjunction with the REGIONAL U.S.A. RAIL Pass are subject to the Conditions of Contract and the rules and regulations of Amtrak which are available for inspection at any Amtrak ticket office.

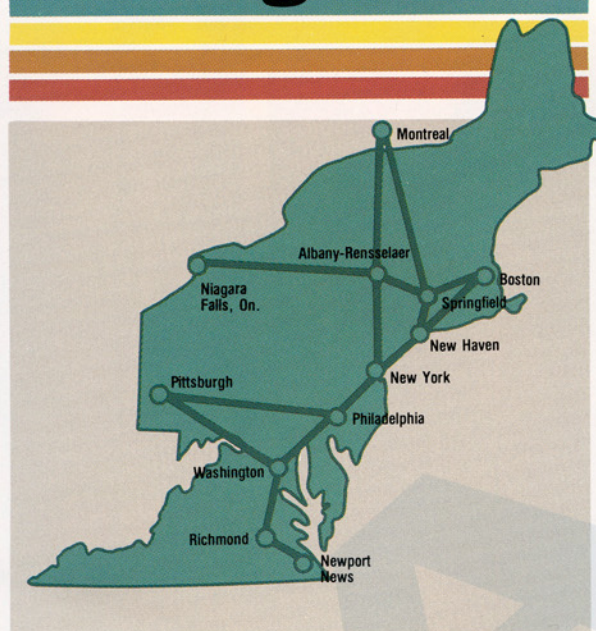

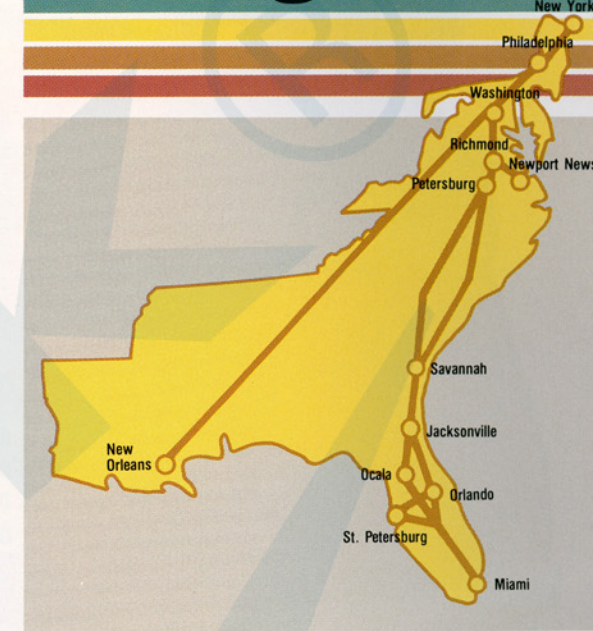
Northeastern Region

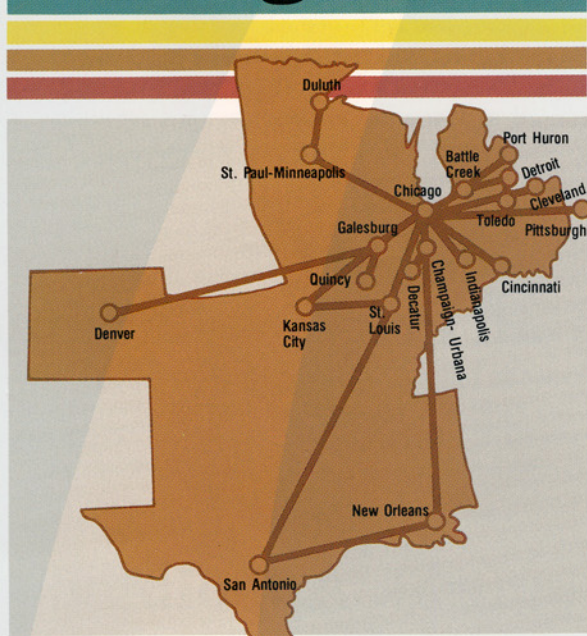
Southern Region

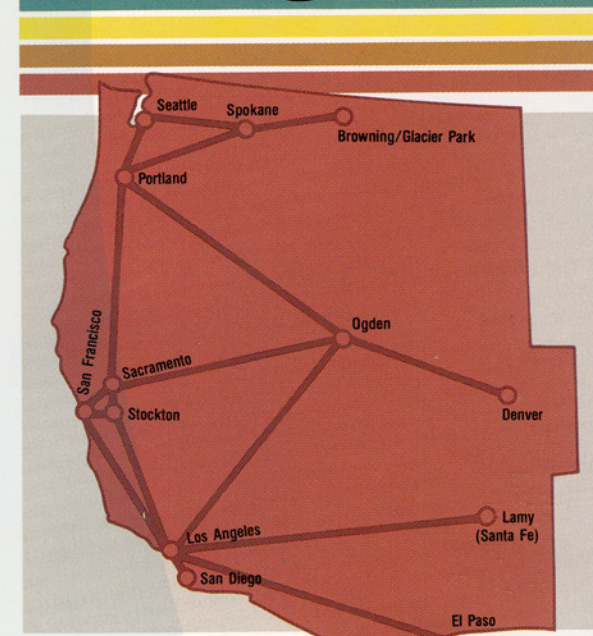
Central Region
