



## TRAVELING BY TRAIN . . .

### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

**SMOKING** — Amtrak wants to make your trip a pleasant one. Because we are concerned about your traveling comfort — and in view of the increased public awareness of smoking and the strong views held by our passengers—we have designated certain NO SMOKING areas. Consequently, smoking WILL be permitted in lounge cars, dining cars, and sleeping cars. Smoking will NOT be permitted in coaches except in areas specifically set aside and identified for smoking in the body of certain coaches and areas such as coach-lounge, bar, grill, and restroom areas. If you smoke, as many of us do, please smoke in designated smoking areas only. Thank you for your cooperation.

**ABOUT CASH FARES** — 25 cents additional is charged aboard trains when passengers board at stations where ticket offices are open at departure time. Avoid this additional charge by purchasing your ticket at the ticket office or from your Amtrak travel agent.

**CREDIT CARDS** — In addition to the Rail Travel Card, Amtrak also accepts American Express, BankAmericard, Carte Blanche, Diners Club and Master Charge — for the purchase of tickets at all Amtrak ticket offices. Amtrak tours can also be charged on these credit cards. The Rail Travel Card only is accepted for on-board charges in diners, lounge cars and Metroclub cars.

**WE LIKE TO HEAR FROM OUR PASSENGERS** — When the news of establishing Amtrak first spread, interested citizens wrote us recounting their personal rail experiences — some good, some not so commendable. Today, almost three years later, your letters continue — and we thank you. Many of your suggestions have become fact; some have not.
