Thrifty Family Plan

Family travel is now more affordable, thanks to Amtrak's Family Plan. The head of the family pays full regular rail fare; spouse and children, ages 12-21, pay only 3/4 of the full adult fare; children, ages 2-11, pay only 3/8 of the adult fare. These fares are good for travel every day of the week, except for travel beginning on Friday and Sunday. The Family Plan fares are good *any time* on the following routes: New Orleans-Los Angeles; St. Louis-Laredo; and Minneapolis-Seattle. Family Plan Fares do not apply to special excursion fares.

Better In Bunches

On Amtrak, groups of 15 or more persons traveling together can save *up to 25 percent* on regular round-trip coach fares—15 percent on regular one-way fares—on all trains except Metroliners between Washington, DC and New Haven, CT. Traveling together on our trains saves a bunch and makes the trip more fun from start to finish!
