If you find that you should require a change in your space after you board the train, we suggest that you check with the conductor to determine whether other types of space might be available.

One of many good things about train travel is that you can get up and move around very freely throughout the train. This freedom enables you to explore the lounge and food areas and to get acquainted with other passengers.



During the time that you spend on board this train, a staff of Amtrak people is here to serve you in a number of different ways. They are:

The Conductor, who is responsible for the overall operation of the train and the collecting of tickets. Several additional trainmen usually assist him.

The Service Attendants, who provide you with the best possible Amtrak hospitality in the coaches, sleeping cars, dining areas and lounges.

The Steward, who manages the dining car and who will direct you to a table.

The Chefs and Cooks, who prepare much of the food served on board the train. You usually do not see them, but they are quietly working behind the scenes to make your time on board more enjoyable.

Welcome Aboard!

We hope you'll relax and enjoy your trip! To help you become acquainted with our train, we'd like to describe the various kinds of car facilities that we have on the Southwest Limited for your pleasure and enjoyment.

High Level Coaches:

This type of accommodation provides two seats on either side of a wide aisle and a view of the entire countryside from an excellent vantage point. The seat backs can be adjusted to a number of reclining positions by pushing in a small button in the arm rest and leaning back



in the seat at the same time. Our coach cars have adjustable foot rests or adjustable leg rests that pull out from under the seat. Overnight coach passengers find that this seating arrangement allows them to enjoy a good night's rest. During this time, the overhead lights are dimmed and pillows are provided for additional passenger comfort.

High Level Coach Lounge Car:

This car is a part of your train only during peak traffic times of the year, such as the popular summer travel period. When it is operating, it is located just behind the high-level dining car

in the coach section. On the upper level, you can enjoy cocktails, beer and soft drinks. On the lower level, there is a Coffee Shop that serves Continental breakfast, sandwiches, a variety of snack items, coffee and beverages.

First Class Dome Lounge Car:

This car is provided for First Class passengers and enables them to enjoy complete cocktails and beverage service in a comfortable and congenial atmosphere. This car is ideal for sight-seeing from individual, parlor-type swivel seats. Special arrangements can be made with the Steward in the dining car to set up a private

dining area in this car for a maximum of eleven people. This kind of service is available only on an advance reservation basis.



High Level Coach Dining Car:

This car is usually located near the middle of the coach section of the train. The view out of the window from your table is especially nice at this high level and is intended to add to your dining

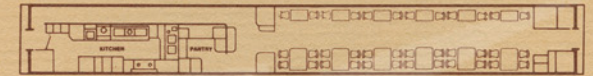


enjoyment. All three daily meals are served in this car. We are sure that you will be pleased with the menu selections, the quality of our food, and the reasonable prices that we charge for it. To add to your dining enjoyment, we provide cocktails, cordials and popular wines.



Single-Level First Class Dining Car:

Provides First Class passengers with a more leisurely and intimate environment in a diner limited to 36 seats. The menu is similar to that



offered in the high level dining car, but with specialties of the chef added. A full liquor, wine and cordial service is offered.

Sleeping Cars:

Another service that is provided for our First Class passengers is the opportunity to enjoy complete privacy and extra comfort through a choice of a roomette, a bedroom or a bedroom suite. A roomette is a small private room that provides a comfortable seat for daytime travel and a fold-down bed for night, plus a private toilet and wash basin. The toilet is covered by



the bed when the bed is in its lowered position. A bedroom is more spacious than a roomette and is ideal for two people. It is also available for one person. There are two separate sleeping berths, plus a private toilet and wash basin.

A limited number of drawing rooms* is available for those who prefer a comfortable setting for up to three passengers. A spacious living room by day, it converts to three full length beds at night.
