TRAVELING BY TRAIN . . . THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

SMOKING — Amtrak wants to make your trip a pleasant one. Because we are concerned about your traveling comfort — and in view of the increased public awareness of smoking and the strong views held by our passengers — we have designated certain NO SMOKING areas. Consequently, smoking WILL be permitted in lounge cars, dining cars, and sleeping cars. Smoking will NOT be permitted in coaches except in areas specifically set aside and identified for smoking in the body of certain coaches and areas such as coach-lounge, bar, grill, and restroom areas. If you smoke, as many of us do, please smoke in designated smoking areas only. Thank you for your cooperation.

CREDIT CARDS — Amtrak accepts American Express, BankAmericard, C&S, Carte Blanche, Diners Club, Eurocard and Master Charge for the purchase of tickets at all Amtrak ticket

offices and for the purchase of meals aboard long-haul dining cars. Amtrak tours can be charged on these credit cards.

TRUST THE MAN WITH THE RED CAP — Many stations along the way employ reliable people to help you with your bags. THEY WEAR RED CAPS. All baggage they handle is protected, and the service is FREE. You have a receipt. A Red Cap can also help you or someone you know who might need a wheelchair, if others offer to help, REFUSE THEIR SERVICE. Their charges are not regulated. It could be unpleasant when time comes to "settle up". Amtrak wishes you a pleasant trip — and wants to keep it that way.

CHECKING AND CLAIMING OF BAGGAGE — Checked baggage will be accepted for checking up to 30 minutes before train departure time and at destination the baggage will be ready for claiming within 30 minutes after train arrival.


CARRY-ON BAGGAGE LIMITATION — In the interest of your common convenience and safety — and when checked baggage service is available — only baggage needed enroute and NOT MORE THAN TWO (2) PIECES OF BAGGAGE PER PASSENGER will be carried into an Amtrak coach. Sleeping car passengers may carry on the baggage which can be safely accommodated within their room. Baggage checking facilities are available at most stations to handle baggage and there is no service charge. Baggage not needed enroute and all bulky items should be checked to destination.

ABOUT CASH FARES — 25 cents additional is charged aboard trains when passengers board at stations where ticket offices are open at departure time. Avoid this additional charge by purchasing your ticket at the ticket office or from your Amtrak travel agent.
