

## Terms and Conditions

1. The SKI PASS is good for bearer and persons accompanying bearer, for up to eight separate one-way coach trips.
2. SKI PASS tickets may not be used for any segment (through train or car) of passenger's travel starting after April 7, 1977. The SKI PASS is *not* good for travel from both original starting point and ski resort station November 24 through November 28, December 16 through 19, and December 24, 26, 30 and 31, 1976; and January 1 through 3, 1977.
3. No stopovers are permitted, except where required for purpose of direct train-to-train transfer.
4. The SKI PASS is good for rail passage only. It is not good for sleeping car, Amclub car or Slumbercoach accommodations charges. The PASS is good for Slumbercoach travel, upon payment of applicable accommodations charges. Upgrading to Metroliner, Amclub car or sleeping car is not permitted more than one hour prior to scheduled train departure from passenger's boarding station.
5. Advance reservations for coach or Slumbercoach service may not be made prior to the purchase of the SKI PASS.
6. Totally unused SKI PASSES will be refunded at full value, upon surrender of ticket coupons containing all eight trips. Partially used SKI PASSES will be refunded at the value remaining. Amtrak will retain full regular fares for each trip used, refunding anything over this amount to the passenger. Any coupons not presented for refund will be considered used.
