

## Responsibility Clause

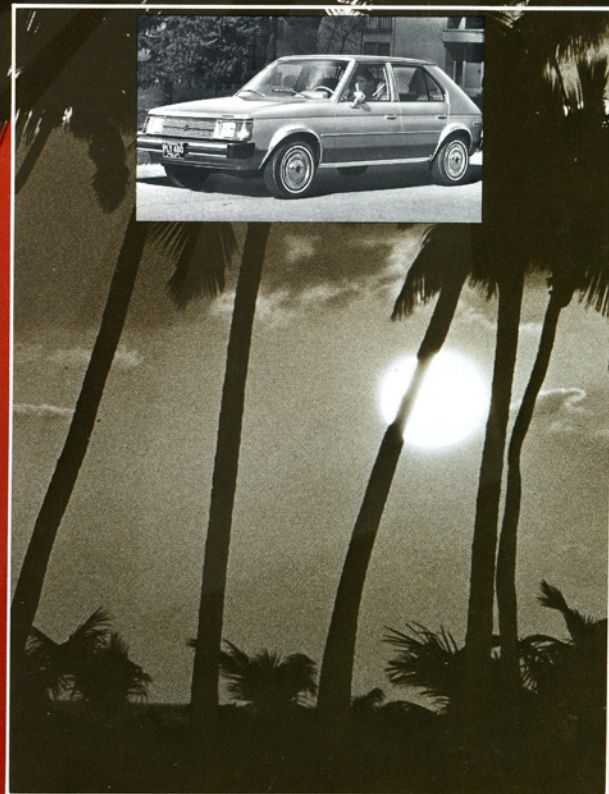

- Larger cars, station wagons and vans are available. The reduced price depends on the number of passengers traveling in the party.
- Cars may also be rented at reduced price for time beyond the first week package plan.

#### Notes:

**Pick up and return:** Cars may be picked up and returned in any of the following cities—Ft. Lauderdale, Miami, Orlando, Tampa. Car pickup is subject to advance reservations and availability.



**Drop-off charge:** A drop-off charge of \$25 will apply if car is picked up and returned at different cities.

**Insurance:** Normal insurance coverage provided. Collision damage waiver available at \$3 per day.

Week of Wheels fares require that passengers travel round-trip by train. Any regular fare, Family Plan or excursion fare will apply.
