The Inside Story

Amtrak's short- and medium-distance trains offer plush reclining coach seats and lots of leg room for added comfort. The convenient drop-down trays make it easy to enjoy a snack, play a game, or do some work, while the individually controlled overhead lighting is perfect for reading.

Ample luggage space for your personal belongings is located directly above your

seat, with limited storage space at the end of the car for those items too large for the luggage racks.

The spacing between the aisles allows you to move freely about the train. And, for your own personal travel enjoyment, we have cars that are fully designated either "smoking" or "non-smoking."

Most of Amtrak's long-distance Eastern routes are served by our Heritage Fleet (HEP). These trains provide a traveling environment that includes comfortable coach seating with leg and foot rests for overnight travel enjoyment. The wide windows in the coach cars give you an opportunity to see views of America you can't see when you're driving on the highway.

You'll also discover Amtrak's cafeteria-lounge cars where you can enjoy the company of family, friends and fellow passengers in a relaxed atmosphere. You can enjoy a wide selection of beverages while reading a book, playing a game, engaging in conversation . . . or by just sitting back and watching the passing scenery.

Lounging Around

On our Heritage Fleet trains, the lounge car is equipped with a food and beverage center where you can enjoy a fine array of hot and cold entrees, snacks, and a wide selection of drinks.

The cafeteria-lounge car is a unique compliment to the fine services available in the dining car where you can experience a pleasure known only to the rail industry. Our full dining cars feature sit-down breakfasts,

lunches and dinners served by our own waiters. You'll choose from menus that feature items flavored by the region your particular train serves.

An Added Feature That Will Put You To Sleep

Our sleeping cars, another fine railroad tradition, offer a wide selection of sleeping accommodations to satisfy the needs of single travelers or families.

Slumbercoaches: Amtrak's slumbercoaches provide the single traveler with the best of private sleeping accommodations at an economical price. These very popular accommodations provide you

with a comfortable seat that converts into a foldaway bed at night.

The double slumbercoach is ideal for two people traveling together. It comes equipped with an upper and lower bed that convert into a sitting area for two during the day.

(Since slumbercoaches do not operate on all long-distance trains, ask about their availability.)

Roomettes:

For the individual traveler looking for a private accommodation, the roomette is larger than a slumbercoach and is equipped with a comfortable seat and a fold-down bed.

Bedrooms:

More spacious than a roomette or double slumbercoach, our bedroom accommodation is ideal for two people traveling together. Each bedroom is equipped with two separate berths for sleeping, and

comfortable lounge seating for daylight travel.

In some instances two adjoining bedrooms have a fold-away wall that can be pulled back to make a bedroom suite for family travel.

All conventional sleeping accommodations have private washing and toilet facilities, reading lights, attendant call systems, individual climate controls, and a Panoramic view of our colorful country.
